



**ACTS OF CANVASSING BOARD
Friday, February 5, 2021

I. Call to Order

Mayor Scott called the meeting of the Board of Canvassers to order all members were present. City Manager Cris Meadows then explained the procedure for canvassing the ballots and opened the ballot boxes for each member present to count the precinct packages.

II. Canvass of the Ballots for the General Election held January 30, 2021

Upon this the 5th day of February 2021, being the fifth day following the Special Excess Levy election held in the City of Hinton, West Virginia, the Council of said city, sitting as a Board of Canvassers, proceeded to canvass said returns by opening each package of ballots laid before them and counting the number of ballots to be exact with the number of poll slips with the results as follows:

All the Ballots were sealed and placed in a storage box to be secured. After which the said board of canvassers examined the returns of the Levy Election and having ascertained the results hereby record the same in the following form, to wit:

The number of ballots voted in the election was 43 in Precinct 11 (Bellepoint), 12 in Precinct 9 (Board Office), and 9 in Precinct 4 (West End) for a total of 64 ballots voted. Upon motion by Councilman Jordan and Seconded by Councilman Meador the Board of Canvassers hereby publicly declare the results of January 30, 2021, Special Excess Levy Election official. The election will be considered final on Wednesday, February 10, 2016.
