Regular Meeting
Tuesday February, 18 2014
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order and the record showed that Council President Larry Meador, Councilwoman Roberta Sorg, and Councilman Bob Basham were all present. City Manager Cris Meadows, Chief of Police Derek Snavelly, Ralph Trout and City Attorney Richard Gunnoe were also in attendance. Councilman Pat Jordan was absent.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – Lynn Maddy led the prayer and the pledge of allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Meador moved to approve the agenda. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Basham moved to approve the minutes of the January 2014 regular city council meeting. Councilman Meador seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Meador moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
6. Approval of Financial Report January 2014 – Councilman Basham moved to approve the financial report January 2014. Councilman Meador seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
7. Approval of Building Permits – Councilman Meador moved to approve the building permits. Councilman Basham seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
8. Appearance of Citizens – Myra Ziegler spoke about the Summers County Library services that are provided and thanked council for their financial support.
9. Discussion and or action regarding Brooks Sewer Project – Mayor Blankenship gave a report on the status of the project. Councilman Meador moved to approve the payment of \$2,627.79. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
10. Discussion and or action regarding Gold Coast Project – Councilman Meador moved to approve the payment of \$1,080.39 and the budget amendment. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
11. Discussion and or action regarding city daycare – Cris discussed the daycare progress and Councilman Meador suggested we maybe partner with the school to save on food costs. Mayor Blankenship read a letter about problems with the fitness center and council discussed different ways to resolve them.
12. Adjournment – Councilman Basham moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
