City Council of Hinton
Regular Meeting
Tuesday December, 16 2014
1:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order and the record showed that Councilman Pat Jordan, Councilman Larry Meador, and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were all present. City Manager Cris Meadows, Chief Pivont, Chief Snavely and City Attorney Richard Gunnoe were also in attendance. Councilman Basham attended by phone conference.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – Cris Meadows led the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Meador moved to approve the agenda. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Jordan moved to approve the minutes of the November 2014 regular city council meeting. Councilman Basham seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilman Meador seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
6. Approval of Financial Report November 2014 – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the financial report November 2014. Councilman Meador seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
7. Approval of Building Permits – Councilman Meador moved to approve the building permits. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
8. Appearance of Citizens – none
9. Discussion and or action regarding franchise agreement with Suddenlink – Councilman Meador moved to dispense with the reading of the ordinance and approve the first reading. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. Council discussed that this was not an exclusive agreement with Suddenlink for their services. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
10. Discussion and or action regarding Brooks Sewer Project – Mayor Blankenship asked for approval of the final payments on the project. Councilman Meador moved to approve the payments totaling \$50,660.68 and the budget revision. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
11. Discussion and or action regarding personnel issues/legal matters – Councilman Jordan moved to go into executive session to discuss personnel and legal matters. Councilman Meador seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0. Council returned from executive session noting no decisions were made.
12. Adjournment – Councilman Jordan moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Meador seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
