



**Acts of  
City Council of Hinton  
Regular Meeting  
Wednesday February, 18 2015  
1:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order and the record showed that Councilman Pat Jordan and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were present. City Manager Cris Meadows, Chief Snively and City Attorney Richard Gunnoe were also in attendance. Councilman Basham and Councilman Meador attended by phone conference.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – Cris Meadows led the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Mayor Blankenship asked to delete items 9, 10, and 12 from the agenda. Councilman Meador agreed and moved to declare this an emergency meeting and to act only on necessary items. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Jordan moved to approve the minutes of the January 2015 regular city council meeting. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
6. Approval of Financial Report January 2015 – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the financial report January 2015. Councilman Basham seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.

Discussion and or action regarding project prioritization – Cris stated he had printed last year's list of projects and since none of them were funded he recommended the same ones but maybe switching them on the list. Mayor Blankenship recommended moving the CSO issue to first, demolition to second, rec center to third, passenger depot to fourth, and possum hollow sewer to fifth. Councilman Meador moved to adopt the list with the mayors recommendations. Councilman Jordan seconded the items and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.

11. Discussion and or action regarding purchase of equipment for fire department – Cris presented council with a purchase request for 24 SCBA cylinders to replace outdated ones. After discussion Councilman Meador moved to purchase 12 now and request Chief Pivont to attend the next meeting and explain the need for the other 12. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
