



**Acts of  
City Council of Hinton  
Regular Meeting  
Tuesday June, 16 2015  
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order and the record showed that Councilman Larry Meador, Councilman Pat Jordan, Councilman Bob Basham and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were present. City Manager Cris Meadows and City Attorney Richard Gunnoe were also in attendance.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – Cris Meadows led the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Basham moved to approve the agenda moving item 10 to the end of the meeting. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Basham moved to approve the minutes of the May 2015 regular city council meeting. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Basham moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
6. Approval of Financial Report May 2015 – Councilman Basham moved to approve the financial report May 2015. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
7. Approval of building permits – Councilman Basham moved to approve the building permits. Councilman Meador seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
8. Appearance of Citizens – none appeared
9. Discussion and or action regarding budget revisions – Council discussed the need to revise the budget due to more income coming in than we had anticipated and the distribution of the excess. Councilman Basham moved to approve the revision. Councilman Meador seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
10. Discussion and or action regarding Mayor's benefits – Councilman Meador moved to go into executive session to discuss personnel. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0. Mayor Blankenship left the room during the executive session. Council President Larry Meador called the meeting back to session and stated he recommended the mayor receive a monthly cell phone reimbursement of \$65.00 per month. Councilman Basham moved to approve a monthly cellphone reimbursement for the mayor in the amount of \$65.00 per month. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0. Councilman Basham moved to allow Mayor Blankenship to buy back into the retirement system. Councilman

Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0. Mayor Blankenship then reentered the meeting room.

11. Discussion and or action regarding lighting upgrade proposal – Cris stated he had been trying to get the Historic Lampposts upgraded to LED to save money and had a proposal to purchase new bulbs for \$8,550.00 that proposed to save up to \$5,000.00 in power bills each year. Councilman Basham moved to approve the purchase of the new bulbs. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
12. Discussion and or action regarding moving Festival of the Rivers to the Freight depot. – Council discussed the request of the volunteers to move to the newly renovated facility and then Councilman Jordan moved to relocate the festival to the new location. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
13. Discussion and or action regarding appoints to boards and offices – Councilman Jordan moved to appoint the following people to their respective positions as noted. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
