



**ACTS OF CANVASSING BOARD
Friday, February 5, 2016
Hinton City Hall – 11:30**

I. Call to Order

Mayor Blankenship called the meeting of the Board of Canvassers to order all members were present except Councilman Meador. City Manager Cris Meadows opened the meeting with a prayer and then led the pledge of allegiance. Cris then explained the procedure for canvassing the ballots and handed each member present one of the precinct packages.

II. Canvass of the Ballots for the General Election held January 30, 2016

Upon this the 5th day of February 2016, being the fifth day following the Special Excess Levy election held in the City of Hinton, West Virginia, the Council of said city, sitting as a Board of Canvassers, proceeded to canvass said returns by opening each package of ballots laid before them and counting the number of ballots to be exact with the number of poll slips with the results as follows:

There was one provisional ballot brought by Cris that the voter was not in the correct precinct it was decided on a motion by Councilman Jordan and seconded by Councilman Mann not to accept the ballot due to voter privacy and it not being able to affect the outcome. The motion passed on a vote of all ayes.

All the Ballots were sealed and placed in a storage box to be secured. After which the said board of canvassers examined the returns of the General Election and having ascertained the results hereby record the same in the following form, to wit:

The number of ballots voted in the election was 50 in Precinct 11 (Bellepoint), 5 in Precinct 9 (Board Office), 8 in Precinct 7 (City Hall), and 12 in Precinct 4 (West End) for a total of 75 ballots voted. Upon motion by Councilman Mann and Seconded by Councilman Jordan the Board of Canvassers hereby publicly declare the results of the January 30, 2016 Special Excess Levy Election official. The election will be considered final on Wednesday, February 10, 2016.
