Regular Meeting  
Tuesday, November 15, 2016  
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order, and the record showed that Councilman Larry Meador, Councilman Jack Scott, Councilman Pat Jordan, and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were present. City Manager Cris Meadows and City Attorney Richard Gunnoe were also in attendance.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – Cris Meadows led the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Meador moved to approve the agenda. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Jordan moved to approve the minutes of the October Regular Council Meeting. Councilman Scott seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
6. Approval of Financial Report October 2016 – Councilman Meador moved to approve the financial report October 2016. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
7. Appearance of Citizens – Cheryl Kula talked to council about a writing program that she received a grant for. She planned on doing another one next year and asked if the council could budget money to help with the expenses. Julia Gaitor thanked the council for efforts to restore the CFM house and help with the Festival of the Rivers.
8. Discussion and or action regarding waterslide project- Council discussed that the contract was signed for a new double waterslide. It should be installed before the Memorial Day opening weekend. Bids were received for demolition of the old slide.
9. Adjournment – Councilwoman Sorg moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
