City Council of Hinton  
Regular Meeting  
Tuesday, February 21, 2017  
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order, and the record showed that Councilman Jack Scott, and Councilman Pat Jordan, Councilwoman Roberta Sorg, and Councilman Meador. City Manager Cris Meadows was absent.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – David Cole led the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the agenda. Councilman Scott seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Jordan moved to approve the minutes of the January regular and special Council Meetings. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
6. Approval of Financial Report January 2016 – Councilwoman Sorg moved to approve the financial report January 2016. Councilman Scott seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
7. Appearance of Citizens – Kim Rodes spoke about the Second Saturdays group and what they are bringing to town and how she feels it will benefit the city.
8. Discussion and or action regarding first reading ordinance for planning commission- Councilman Meador moved to approve the first reading of the ordinance establishing a planning commission for the city. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
9. Discussion and or action regarding bank accounts – Councilwoman Sorg stated that the committee which included Cris Meadows, Mary Taylor, Haley Lane and herself. They recommended First Community Bank. Mayor Blankenship wanted it noted that he didn't have any input into this and he let the committee set up the meetings with the banks and handle it themselves and he supported their decision. Councilman Jordan also stated he had no input into the decision. Councilman Meador made the motion to move the accounts. Councilman Scott seconded the motion. The Motion passed 3-0 with Councilman Jordan abstaining.

Councilman Scott moved to approve the list. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.

12. Discussion and or action regarding Second Saturdays – Councilman Scott discussed the details of the activities May – October each second Saturday of the month. Councilman Meador moved to approve the event and support it. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0
13. Discussion and or action regarding waterslide – Mike O’Neal met with council and discussed the details of the waterslide project. Councilman Jordan moved to approve the proposal of costs as presented. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion and the motion passed 4-0.
14. Councilwoman Sorg moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
