



**Acts of
City Council of Hinton
Regular Meeting
Tuesday, February 18, 2020
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order, and the record showed that Councilman Jack Scott, Councilman Pat Jordan, Councilman Larry Meador, and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were present.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – Cris Meadows led the prayer and pledge.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Meador moved to approve the agenda. Councilman Scott seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Meador made a motion to approve the minutes from the regular January meeting. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilwoman Sorg moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
6. Approval of financial report – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the January 2020 financial report. Councilman Meador seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0. Mayor Blankenship had to leave and Council President Larry Meador took over as chair for the meeting.
7. The Appearance of Citizens – Sara Mattis asked council to consider repairing or paving 3rd Ave above James street and the alley connecting it with 2nd Ave. Andrew Monti stated he would like to offer parking in front of his building for fitness center custores if we could provide a two hour parking only sign. He also asked if the Hardwoods building was for sale and council sated they are looking at leasing it out at this time. Ron Iddings asked about putting a trash can in front of the old Hot Dog Stand building for his soup kitchen to use.
8. Discussion and or action regarding project prioritization – Councilman Meador read the prioritization as presented. Council discussed the category list and agreed with the rankings and then discussed the project list and decided it best to drop the amphitheater to 5th and move the river access improvements to 3rd. Councilman Scott moved to approve the list with the changes noted. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion was approved on a vote of 3-0.

9. Discussion and or action regarding resolution HUD WVPRI grant – Council read and adopted the resolution in support of the grant/loan for code enforcement. Councilman Jordan moved to adopt the resolution in support of the program. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion and the motion passed on vote of 3-0.
