Regular Meeting
Tuesday, March 21, 2017
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order, and the record showed that Councilman Jack Scott, Councilman Meador, Councilman Pat Jordan, and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were present.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – City Manager Cris Meadows led the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the agenda. Councilman Scott seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilwoman Sorg moved to approve the minutes of the February Regular Council Meeting. Councilman Scott seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
