City Council of Hinton
Regular Meeting
Tuesday, October 15, 2019
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order, and the record showed that Councilman Jack Scott, Councilman Pat Jordan, and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were present. Councilman Meador was absent.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – Cris Meadows led the prayer and pledge.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilwoman Sorg moved to approve the agenda. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Jordan moved to approve the minutes of the September regular meeting. Councilman Scott seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 3-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Scott moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 3-0.
6. Approval of financial report – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the September 2019 financial report. Councilman Scott seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 3-0.
7. The Appearance of Citizens – none
8. Discussion and or action regarding Complete Streets Resolution – Erin Reed with ACTIV Southern West Virginia discussed with council the benefits of becoming a Complete Streets community and how it benefits the citizens with safer sidewalks and streets. Councilman Scott moved to approve the resolution in support of the complete streets program. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
9. Discussion and or action regarding census resolution – Debbie Sizemore from the US Census program gave a presentation to the council on the importance of the Census and how it works. Councilwoman Sorg moved to approve the resolution in support of the census. Councilman Scott seconded the motion and the motion was approved on a vote of 3-0.
10. Discussion and or action regarding Batteau Beach – Rick Moorefield presented a concept plan on the area around the beach. Kent Bartgis stated that Mr. Cole in Lewisburg in charge of the area DOH and would be the contact point for the property that the city needs to make the project work. Cris stated that the project will not work without the extra property. Mayor Blankenship appointed a special committee in charge of the project which included the Council, Mayor, City Manager, Billy Gill, Kent Bartgis, and Rick Moorefield and Councilman Jordan will chair the committee.
