1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Jack Scott called the virtual meeting to order, and the record showed that Council President Pat Jordan, Councilman Jim Leslie, Councilman Larry Meador, and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were all present.
2. Council discussed planning for public works projects for the next year and immediate future and how some of those options could be carried out. They had discussions about the demolition program, the new public restroom to be built behind the railroad museum, the streetscape development, spring cleanup and hiring the seasonal workers. Legal council discussed the home rule application that was being developed and the follow-up on the demolition.
There was discussion on the grant opportunities for city properties like the Hardwoods building. There was also much discussion on the Hinton Landing project and how to promote Amtrak usage along with tenants for the tech center. Council discussed hiring a Retail development manager to help bring business to town as well as helping existing businesses.

In conformity with West Virginia Code , no decisions were made and no votes were taken.
